

**Sermon Discussion Questions for October 11**  
***“Confidence in God’s Supernatural Protection” I Samuel 19:1-24***

1. Looking back over your life, has there ever been a time when God has provided supernatural protection in your life? How?
2. In I Samuel 19:2-7, what character qualities does Jonathan exhibit that would strengthen his friendship with David?
3. How has God used a friend to strengthen you when you have faced a difficult situation?
4. Based on I Samuel 19:8-10, Against what do we need to pray? For what do we need to pray? How could Ephesians 6:10-18 aid us in these kinds of prayers?
5. In I Samuel 19:11-17, how does David’s wife Michal protect David? What do you think motivates her to protect David?
6. What character flaws do you see in David’s wife and family in I Samuel 19:9-17? How are you encouraged or discouraged by David’s imperfect family?
7. In I Samuel 19:18-24, how does God uniquely provide protection for David and Samuel? What can we learn about God’s protection from this situation?
8. Define the word “trust.” Who do you go to when you are threatened by an enemy? Why? Who should we ultimately trust for our protection?
