Genesis 18:1-33

Intercessors delight in the personal fellowship with God. Genesis 18:1-8

- 1. Define the word intercessor. What are the character qualities of an intercessor?**
- 2. When have you been an intercessor for another? What motivated you to pray?**
- 3. Has there been someone to intercede on your behalf? What effect did that person's prayers have on your life?**

Intercessors stand firm in God's promises even when others waver. Genesis 18:9-15

- 4. What makes a person a powerful prayer warrior?**

Intercessors urgently plead with God on behalf of others. Genesis 18:16-33

- 5. Read Rom.8:26 and Hebrews 7:25. What do these verses teach you about intercession? How do you feel about these scriptures?**
- 6. How do you know when the Lord is prompting you to pray for someone? For whom is the Lord prompting you to pray?**
- 7. Based on this week's sermon, how does God prepare us to be powerful intercessors?**
