Introduction: God uses three kinds of humble people who are available to serve Him and trust Him against great odds.

1. *EHUD* – God uses people with significant personal handicaps. *Judges 3:15-30*

- A. Ehud is the second judge of Israel. 3:15a, c
- B. Ehud's handicap is his left-handedness. 3:15b
- C. Ehud uses his handicap to his advantage. 3:16
- D. Handicaps don't disqualify us from making an impact.

2. *SHAMGAR* – God uses people without the necessary tools. *Judges 3:31*

- A. Shamgar came from a questionable background. 3:31
- B. Shamgar faced a formidable enemy. 3:31
- C. Shamgar used a completely unwieldy tool. 3:31
- D. Lack of resources doesn't disqualify us from making an impact.

3. *DEBORAH/JAEL* – God uses those who lack the world's respect. *Judges 4:1-5:31*
