2. THE COST – Discipleship invites spiritual warfare. 2 Timothy. 1:15-18, 2:1

- A. That raises a question: If this invites warfare, why do it?
- B. Paul gives a comparison in verses 15-18 of “the many” versus “the one.”
- C. The negative example: Many people have left Paul including two men who were well known.
- D. The positive example: Onesiphorus is committed to Paul and active in personal ministry.

3. THE STRENGTH – The power for discipleship comes from the indwelling Christ. 2 Timothy 2:1

- A. The command: be strong.
- B. The reason for the command: we can’t do this ourselves.
