SERMON ON THE MOUNT Week 13

Read Matthew 6:25-33

Note: Unlike the previous passage that focused on our tendency to store up for ourselves out of entitlement and self-indulgence, this passage shows the danger of the other side of the coin – worry about our basic needs.

Retell: Summarize in your own words what Jesus is saying about money and our needs.

Discuss: How does worry about our earthly needs lead us away from serving God?

How can you work to meet your needs without violating this warning?

What does this passage tell us about God's care and providence?

What worries of life tend to drive you toward anxiety? Why is it hard to trust God for those things?

Application: Take a moment to pray and listen. What practical things can you do to combat anxiety about your (or your family's) needs? Write it down and share it with the group.
